Town Meeting Minutes  
October 20, 2016  
Town Hall, 50 Cemetery Road  
Meeting Room

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Craig Nelson, First Selectman.

J. Richardson moved to appoint Craig Nelson moderator, second by D. Ohmen. All in favor.

The clerk read the call to the meeting.

1. B. Bolte nominated Susie Bates and Howard Lethbridge to 4 year terms on the Planning & Zoning Commission, second by R. Hodza. B. Bolte moved the nominations be closed, second by J. Richardson. All in favor of closing the nominations. The clerk cast a ballot for Susie Bates and Howard Lethbridge.
2. B. Bolte nominated Brian Coyle to a 3 year term as alternate on the Planning & Zoning Commission, second by J. Schultz. J. Richardson moved to close the nominations, second by D. Dacey. All in favor of closing the nominations. The clerk cast a ballot for Brian Coyle.
3. D. Dacey moved to adopt an ordinance regarding the number of members and alternates on the Park & Recreation Commission, second by C. Frisbie. It was explained that the commission has trouble meeting quorum with its current configuration. All in favor, the motion carried.
4. C. Frisbie move to adopt an updated ordinance regarding implementing the requirements of solid waste management, second by D. Ohmen. It was explained that this is an update of an ordinance of 1988 to bring it into compliance with state law. All in favor, the motion carried.
5. Other business:
  - a. Tim Angevine asked about the reverse 911 system. We used to have a program called Blackboard that was maintained by the town and would now cost \$1670/year. We now use the Everbridge system which goes through the state. There was discussion regarding this system and the time frame for getting an alert out to residents.  
J. Schultz moved to authorize the selectmen to investigate returning to the Blackboard system, second by B. Bolte. All in favor, the motion carried.
  - b. Craig announced that a representative from Copes Waste will be here to meet with residents on November 17, time to be determined.
  - c. Craig also announced that we are in need of a new Democratic Registrar of Voters.
  - d. Bears were discussed, and the DEEP will be presenting a program "Living with Bears" in the near future.

D. Dacey moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:50 pm, second by C. Frisbie. All in favor.
