**WHS:** collaboration with Kent on 18<sup>th</sup> Century Series, Sloan Museum with the Warren School, Scholarship applications due May 1<sup>st</sup>, Heritage Arts Program – working with

school aged children and then will be hosting an Open House to promote the art work – suggested hanging the children's work at the Town Hall for viewing instead of the dining hall at the Community Center – happening throughout the month of May

**Park and Rec:** Has 3 concert dates with the possibility of 2 additional dates – giving organizations an opportunity to have some type of event with the concert – i.e. Church has the Chicken BBQ with Truck Stop Troubadours, VMC grills for 1-2 events) Movie at the Beach, possible Winter Carnival or a Dog Day Event D. Murphy expressed pooling email lists to reach more residents/patrons with all Town events/happenings

Everyone agreed that the Holiday on the Hill festivities need to be re-vamped. A suggestion to form a special committee to work together to make this event better – possible music, Santa arriving to start the night, special activities to get families more involved in the event, etc.
