

Connecticut Department of Motor Vehicles FAQ Sheet:

All Connecticut residents with a vehicle registration, driver's license, or non-driver ID card must update the DMV **within 48 hours of any change of address**. Changes made online are effective once your transaction has been successfully processed. Statutes for non-compliance penalties have been approved by the governor and are being proposed throughout the state.

Once you have established residency in Connecticut, you have **30 days** to transfer your out-of-state license and car registration to Connecticut.

The estimated time to change your address online: 5-7 minutes
