Telecommunications: a) Nelson met with a representative from a company that would evaluate all town facility communications to see if we could save money representative receives pay based on 50% of what the town saves: program is for 36 months All Selectmen feel we could do this on our own since the program/contract would be for 36 months b) Update on Verizon: our representative has not called us back on our questions, come to find out he has moved up in the company and they are in the process of hiring a new representative for our area. Once hired, we will be contacted and be able to hopefully resolve the issues in question.
- 5. First Selectman's Report: 1) All the Towns received a letter from the DOJ regarding referendums initiated by a "complaint". Nelson has joined roughly 146 other towns in having a lawyer draft a rebuttal letter to the DOJ in response to their letter. 2) At the last COG meeting the DOT was there and spoke about walking and bicycle routes/trails. Nelson wants to apply with Washington, CT, for a road safety audit regarding the road around Lake Waramaug, which would identify counter-measures to help improve safety. This route is the heaviest used bicycle route in the Northwest Corner of Connecticut.
