Absentee Ballot Applications and Voting

The Secretary of the State has sent an absentee ballot application to every voter eligible to vote in the August 11, 2020 Presidential Preference Primary (registered Democrats and Republicans). Pursuant to Executive Order 7QQ, COVID-19 may be used as a valid reason for requesting an absentee ballot.

Please complete and use the provided prepaid return envelope, making sure the Town of Warren address appears in the window.

If you did not receive an application you may:

- Call the Town Clerk at 860-868-7881 and request an application

Voting by absentee is an option for those who do not wish to go to the polling location. The polling location will be open from 6am to 8pm for those who wish to vote at the polls. If you do not want to receive an absentee ballot please destroy the application as you see fit.

Absentee ballots become available July 21 and will be mailed out by a mail house. The completed ballot can be returned to the Town Clerk either by mail or by inserting it into a designated ballot box that will be placed outside at Town Hall.

Should you wish to vote at the polling location the Registrars of Voters will be following guidelines from the CDC and the Secretary of the State's office to keep the polls safe.
