INSTRUCTIONS **2020**
FOR PARKING PERMIT APPLICATION

NEW PROCEDURES FOR 2020

We invite you to complete an application for a Town of Warren Parking Permit for 2020. Parking permits are required in order to park at the Town Beach. Each form allows for two different vehicles to apply for permits. Should you have more than two vehicles that you plan to park at the Town Beach, you will need to fill out an additional application. All vehicles must be registered to the Warren property taxpayer, or to a tenant of the Warren property taxpayer. If you are renting, you will be asked for a copy of your lease agreement.

To obtain a Town of Warren Beach Parking Permit all taxes in the Town of Warren must be current. If taxes are delinquent a beach pass will not be issued.

Please submit the following:

1. Completed application form-***Please type into fillable form and print out.***
2. Copy of the registration certificate issued by your state Department of Motor Vehicles for each vehicle. **No Exceptions.**
3. Signed acknowledgement of your acceptance of the **Warren Town Beach Rules** (Page 3 of the Application)
4. Fee(s), accordingly, as follows.
5. A Self-addressed stamped envelope.

Residents:

- a check payable to: "Warren Parks & Recreation" in the amount of \$30.00 *per vehicle*.

Former residents with resident family members:

- a check payable to: "Warren Parks & Recreation" in the amount of \$100.00 *per vehicle*.

Non-resident renters:

- a copy of your current lease
- a check payable to: "Warren Parks & Recreation" in the amount of \$150.00 *per vehicle* for season pass parking permit or \$30.00 for a one-day pass parking permit.

Senior residents at least age 65:

- a single vehicle is FREE!
- additional permits are \$20.00 *per vehicle*, make check payable to "Warren Parks & Recreation."

To have your Town of Warren Parking Permit Application processed, you must either:

- Go to Town Hall during regular business hours (Mon & Thurs 9-1, Tues & Wed 9-4) or
- Submit by mail to Warren Parks & Recreation, Town of Warren, 50 Cemetery Rd, Warren, CT 06754 along with a SELF-ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE *as soon as possible* as processing through the mail may take a week or more! **PLAN AHEAD!!**

Permits will no longer be sold at the beach. All town taxes must be current.

If taxes are delinquent a parking permit will not be issued.

WARREN TOWN BEACH RULES

USE OF THE BEACH:

- The beach may be used by Warren residents, taxpayers, and their guests.
- All vehicles must have a current Town of Warren Parking Permit affixed to the windshield.
- Parking permits will be checked by the gate attendant.
- Cars without parking permits will not be allowed to park.
- New Health and safety regulations will be implemented in order to protect everyone that uses the beach in this difficult time: Please understand that entrance into the beach is not guaranteed due to new capacity regulations.

SEASONAL HOURS:

- The beach opens Memorial Day weekend. The beach is open daily from 9 AM – 8 PM.
- The beach closes after Labor Day weekend.

SWIMMING AREA:

- Ropes with buoys designate the boundaries of the swimming area.
- No boats, kayaks, canoes or paddleboards allowed in designated swimming area.

LIFEGUARD:

- Every effort will be made to have a Lifeguard on duty from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- No children are allowed on the premises without adult supervision (at least 18 years old).
- Parents/guardians are responsible for supervising their children at all times, in all areas of the park; the Lifeguards are not babysitters!
- The Lifeguard is equipped with a first aid kit and a phone is available for emergencies.
- Only Coast Guard approved life jackets are allowed at the beach; please have the fit of life jackets checked by a lifeguard/Gate guard if on duty.
- Inflatable, flotation devices are not allowed.
- Kickboards may be permitted at times, providing that they are used in a safe manner, and *at the Lifeguard's sole discretion*, in the interest of safety.

BOAT LAUNCHING:

- Only watercraft that are carried by hand may be launched from the designated area on the far left past the swimming areas. Please use the left gate to move watercrafts and do not move them through or over the bushes.
- No trailers or vehicles are to be used for launching boats.
- No trailers are to be left in the parking area at the beach at any time.

SAIL BOATS:

- Sails *will not* be hoisted in the buoyed area when entering or leaving the beach.

PICNIC AREA:

- Picnic tables are to be shared.
- Tables may not be "staked out" or reserved for an entire day.
- After eating, clear the table so that others may use it.
- Use trash cans on site and do not litter.
- Fires are allowed in the established cooking grills *only*. Absolutely no other fires are allowed.

PARKING:

- Vehicles are allowed in the parking area only.
- No motor vehicles allowed on the beach or in the picnic area.
- ALL vehicles **must** have and display a 2020 Town of Warren Parking Permit.

PLAYSCAPE:

- Children must be supervised at all times.
- Ensure that children play safely.
- Climbing on top of the play scape is dangerous and **strictly prohibited**.
- Please help us keep our children safe!

OTHER:

- No dogs or pets are allowed.
- No fishing from the shore or boats near the swimming area.
- Only soft (Nerf® or similar) balls are to be used to play catch in the park.
- Beach staff always have the final word on the administration and interpretation of all beach rules.

HEALTH & SAFETY:

- Masks/face coverings are to be worn when entering/exiting the beach and interacting with people outside your immediate family. Masks/face coverings may be taken off after reaching your designated area on the beach or grass. Masks/face coverings do not have to be worn when in the water.
- Social distancing is always to be followed when on the premises, including the parking lot, grass area, beach, and in the water.
- Social distancing on the beach will be marked in 15 foot increments. Please proceed to an empty area when entering the beach and remain in that space when occupying the beach.

Everyone's cooperation in adhering to these rules is needed to maintain a safe, healthy, beautiful, and enjoyable beach. I hereby agree to adhere to the rules stated above, and acknowledge that beach staff always have the final word on the administration and interpretation of all beach rules. I also agree to ensure all the children in my care will use the beach and play scape in a manner consistent with these rules and the guests I bring will also act accordingly. I acknowledge that at this time there will be no refunds for purchased 2020 beach parking permits.
