MINUTES:

Introductions:

- Jocelyn Ayer introduced herself as the Community & Economic Development Director of Northwest Hills Council of Governments which serves 21 towns in the region. She has many years of experience staffing the NWCT Regional Housing Council, serving on her town's Housing Commission and non-profit housing organization, and assisted in the development of the Town of Salisbury's Affordable Housing Plan in 2018. Ayer explained that the Town has entered into a contract with NHCOG to provide professional planning assistance with Warren's Housing Plan with grant funds provided to the Town through the Department of Housing.
- Each member of the Warren Housing Plan Steering Committee then introduced themselves and briefly shared their backgrounds.

Slide presentation:

 Ayer then presented slides covering the following topics -What is in a town housing plan? and what is the purpose? What is the role of the Steering Committee? How is "affordable housing" defined? Discussion of possible resident housing needs survey:
