## INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION OF TIMBER HARVESTING

1. **Filing fee** must accompany application. Check made payable to Town of Warren. **(See Schedule of Fees Attached)**.

2. Four copies of the complete application should be filed with the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, or secretary by the first business day of the month to be acted on at the regular monthly meeting on the second Tuesday of the month.

3. Please print or type the information requested in all spaces indicated.

4. On the line "Location of Property": Locate the property by approximate distance and direction from a road junction or other landmark or by a small location sketch (1" equal 2000') which can be put on the map accompanying the application.

5. Four copies of a map of the timber harvesting area must accompany the application. This must be of sufficient accuracy for the Commission to determine compliance with the Regulations. It must show the following information:

- A. boundaries and names of adjacent property owners and the North arrow;
- B. all access roads to logging areas;
- C. location of inland-wetlands;
- D. all streams, seasonal or perennial, ponds, lakes, or reservoirs;
- E. location of all proposed and existing roads and main skid trails;
- F. contours at 10-foot intervals may be required to show slope of roads and main skid trails;
- G. location of yarding and landing areas.

6. If the logging operation is in or affects a regulated area of inland wetlands and watercourses, a statement from the Warren Conservation & Inland Wetlands Commission must be attached to this application showing that the requirements of the Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Regulations of the Town of Warren are being complied with. A map of the Inland Wetlands and Watercourses is on file at the Town Hall. 7. The driveway connection must comply with the Driveway Ordinance of the Town of Warren (if connecting to a town road), or with the Encroachment Permit Regulations of the CT Dept. of Transportation (if connecting to a state highway). Approval for the driveway connection plan must be noted on the application by the signature of the First Selectman or the signature of the State Dept. of Transportation Permit Investigator, Mr. Joseph Snow, 94 Railroad Street, New Milford, CT.
