Don said he is trying to get a Fleetwood Mac tribute band for next July 15. He would like to include food trucks and a beer/wine dispenser truck.

Kirby reported that they would like to get the elementary schools to participate in the Cider Run on October 22. She is also working on getting t-shirts and confirming Fast-Track Timing. Don mentioned perhaps getting a bounce-house for the youngsters. Kirby said there is a need for runners and walkers.
