Re: Land Use Applications of Paul Szymanski, PE for Plumb Project, Kent Road/Route 341, Warren Special Exception Application to the Warren Planning and Zoning Commission and Application for Wetlands Permit to the Warren Inland Wetlands and Conservation Commission

Due to the COVID 19 Pandemic and the recent restrictions imposed, the above noted applications submitted by Paul Szymanski, PE for the Plumb Project located on Kent Road/Route 341 will be tabled until at least the May or June meetings of the Warren Land Use Commissions. The members of the Planning and Zoning Commission and the Inland Wetlands and Conservation Commission want to reassure the public that this process will move forward in transparent manner with plenty of opportunity for public comment.

Planning and Zoning: The Public Hearing for the Special Exception before the Planning and Zoning Commission is scheduled to open at the April 14th meeting. At that time the hearing will be opened by the Commission and then immediately tabled until the May 12th regular meeting with no discussion of the application.

Inland Wetlands and Conservation Commission: The next meeting of the Inland Wetlands and Conservation Commission is scheduled for April 23rd. At that meeting the Commission will accept a letter of extension to allow consideration of the application to be carried over until the May 28th meeting. There will be no discussion of the application at that meeting.
