- 5) Fire Company on Fire Water Resources: T. Pettit gave an overview of the hydrants in town and how one of the main hydrants in the center of Town is not working. The other 2 not working are on Tanner Hill and Town Hill Rd Town will need to repair the hydrants on Town property and someone will need to contact the hydrants on private property. Fire company doesn't have the resources to repair the hydrants. Pettit gave the Selectmen a list of hydrants in Town.
- 6) Fire Company on Insurance review: J. Marsh gave an overview of replacement costs for trucks and would like to increase accordingly.
