Town Meeting Minutes  
October 21, 2021  
Warren Woods, Brick School Road

The meeting was called to order at 7:40 pm by Tim Angevine, First Selectman.

R. Newton nominated Jack Travers as moderator, second by V. Sahadevan Fossland. C. Nelson moved to close nominations, second by C. Frisbie. All in favor.

1. The moderator began the meeting with the presentation of the draft Housing Plan. Jocelyn Ayers of NWHCOG presented the plan along with Victoria Sahadevan Fossland.

The clerk then read the call to the meeting.

E. Schoenfeld moved to accept the Housing Plan as presented. Second by C. Frisbie. Questions and discussion followed. Vote was taken by paper ballot. Yes-86, No-11. The motion carried.

2. Two seats on the Planning & Zoning Commission were up for election. V.Sahadevan Fossland moved to elect Ruth Schnell to the first seat, term ending 10/2025. Second by Katia Zero. C. Frisbie moved to close nominations, second by T. Keith. The clerk cast one ballot for Ruth Schnell.

V. Sahadevan Fossland nominated Paul Prindle to fill the second seat, term ending 10/2025. Second by R. Schnell. R. Schnell moved to close nominations, second by Josh Tanner. All in favor of closing nominations. The clerk cast one ballot for Paul Prindle.

One alternate seat on the Planning & Zoning Commission was up for election. Jesse Travers nominated Pete Sandberg for the term ending 10/2024. Second by K. Newton. V. Sahadevan Fossland moved to closed nominations, second by Calvin Tanner. All in favor of closing nominations. The clerk cast one ballot for Pete

Sandberg.

3. R. Newton moved to vote on the Warren Community Garden @ Wasley Farm-resolved that the Town of Warren consider leasing a portion of the Wasley Farm to the legal entity representing the Warren Community Garden @ Wasley Farm (WCG) to establish and operate a community garden and orchard for the benefit of Warren Town Residents. The Board of Selectmen will be given the authority to finalize the details of the lease, including the term of the lease, the legal entity that will enter the lease on behalf of the WCG and the exact location and dimensions of the garden. Second by Jesse Travers. Questions and discussion followed. A vote was taken by paper ballot. Yes-68, No-28. The motion carried.

Jesse Travers moved to adjourn at 8:52pm, second by P. Sandberg. All in favor.
