

Elizabeth Park – The Rose Garden



THURSDAY, JUNE 14, 2018

Journey to the heart of Elizabeth Park in West Hartford. Opened in 1904, the Rose Garden is the first municipal rose garden in the United States and the *third largest* rose garden in the country today! The original design of the main garden, called the “Square,” is an acre in size and has 132 rose beds. It has a center circle and eight pathways. The North and South gardens, which are semi-circular sections, were added later to make up a total of 2.5 acres of roses, 475 beds, and the eight grass pathways. The wide paths were designed to accommodate larger crowds. Boasting over 15,000 bushes and 800 varieties of old and new roses in the garden, Elizabeth Park is listed on the National Register of Historical Places.

After our visit we treat ourselves to lunch at a local restaurant. Depart Warren Community Center at 9:00 a.m.
