Beginning the week of July 4th, 2016, Copes Waste Solutions will be collecting household trash & recycling for the Town of Warren. Pickups will occur on Monday with trash collected every week, and recycling collected every other week. When a holiday falls on a Monday, collections will take place on Tuesday.

We will be providing two 95 gallon barrels per household for collection. The barrels need to be placed curbside either Sunday night or Monday morning. Collection will begin at 6am each Monday. Barrels will be delivered starting on Saturday, June 25th, and continuing through the week of June 27th, with our first pickup on July 5th.

Attached to your barrels will be a holiday & recycling calendar, a recycling information sheet, and details about the first weeks of collection to help ease the transition. Our office is available at 860-274-1444 Monday through Thursday from 8a to 4p, and Friday from 8a to 3p, to answer any questions you may have.

Any resident who would prefer to have in-yard service can make arrangements through our office at 860-274-1444. This service costs \$25 per month and will be billed directly.

We look forward to working with the Town of Warren and its residents and are committed to providing excellent service over the life of our contract.

YOUR RECYCLING PROGRAM IS BETTER AND **GREENER** THAN EVER!

BEGINNING TODAY the following items will be acceptable:

- **All food, beverage and laundry containers made of Plastic #1 through #7, up to 3 gallons** (rinse but do not crush) (no black plastics, no Styrofoam, or other foam plastics)
- **Mixed paper** - newspapers, magazines, telephone books, bills, receipts, junk mail, computer & office paper. (shred bills and receipts to destroy personal information)
- **Corrugated cardboard and chipboard (no larger than 2ft X 2ft)** cereal boxes, shoe boxes, pasta boxes (remove cereal box linings and pasta box windows)
- **Unbroken glass food and drink jars and bottles** (rinse, leave labels on, discard caps and lids)
- **Food and Beverage Aluminum Containers and aerosol cans** - up to 3 gallons - rinse but do not crush. (No paint, pesticides or other hazardous wastes)
- **Juice boxes and milk or juice containers** (rinse and remove caps and straws)
- **Hardbound books**, only if covers have been removed & placed in trash
- **Large plastic toys, beverage crates, laundry baskets, recycling bins, and storage containers** - provided that they can fit into a Single Stream Container and ALL METALS HAVE BEEN REMOVED.
