

## Important Upcoming Voter Registration Dates

### Monday May 11<sup>th</sup>:

This is the last day that an enrolled elector can transfer from one party to another and be eligible to vote in the August 11th Presidential Primary.

Seventeen year olds are allowed to register to vote if they will turn 18 by the November election. They are allowed to vote in the primary for the upcoming election. They are not allowed to vote at local referenda, town committee primaries or to participate in caucuses.

Because of the ever changing landscape for this year's Presidential Primary ***on line voter registration is highly encouraged***. Go to

### August 6th:

Deadline for *new voters*, and for *unaffiliated voters*, to *enroll in a party* for voting in it's primary. For *new voters*, mail-in applications must be *postmarked*, or received by Registrar of Voters or the Town Clerk's office by this date. For *unaffiliated voters*, the mail-in application must be received (not merely postmarked) by the Registrar of Voters by this deadline.

### August 10th, by noon:

In-person enrollment deadline, for new voters and unaffiliated voters enrolling in a party *in person at Town Hall*, for voting in primary.
