Meeting called to order at 7:00pm by Wilson

- **1.** Wilson received M. Pettit's resignation from the Committee *Motion (Dacey/Bolte) to accept Pettit's resignation* **All Approved**
- 2. Minutes: Motion (Dacey/Bolte) to approve the minutes of the November 28, 2017 All Approved
- **3.** Income Update: balance as of 6/26/19 \$15,000

Still a discrepancy with Bethlehem Masonry – should only be the tax originally paid but now another error which Frisbie is researching and will go to Bethlehem Masonry to work it out with the accountant Until then, the \$15,000 reflects the net if we are incorrect with our estimates with Masonry. This \$15,000 also takes in the 5/6 names to be on the capstone – so only \$13,800 is available. Frisbie reviewed the amount of funds from different fundraisers – concert food fundraisers only grossed \$600 each summer

- 4. Fundraising: Dacey asked J. Favreau (WHS) if the VMC would be able to set up a Go Fund Me account to help raise funds for the memorial. WHS said it would be okay with them. Motion (Dacey/Bolte) to have Dacey investigate and possibly create a Go Fund Me account All Approved Dacey will come back to the commission with information, wording, fees etc.
- 5. Construction Update: (A) N. Brodhead presented the quote from Chester Granite (see 1st attachment) Questions: could the sides of the stones be shaved where the engraving would be? Would this change the price of each letter? Would the lettering for the Heading be larger and is there a different charge for that size lettering? MacNeil thought if the sides where shaved, the lettering would stand out more Wilson confirmed that is what A Williams from Chester Granite had told him. Could you get pricing on having the Military Emblems engraved on the stones? Would like to have 3 emblems on each stone and the Purple Heart Emblem on the back of each stone. The Military Emblems should be 6" and the Purple Heart Emblem should be 10". Wilson thought there were 2 rods in each stone for stabilization could Brodhead please double check that information? Had to increase the bottom line at this time to take in consideration that there are more letters than quoted up to 1380 letters for names and 75 letters for the headings Bottom line increased to \$18,590

(B) Dacey presented the quote from Barre VT (see 2nd attachment) *Questions:* the quote has the emblems on it, but in 4", could you get quote with the 6" emblems and the 10" Purple Heart emblems (2) - 3 on each stone so we can compare both quotes next meeting Brodhead and Dacey will gather information for the next meeting. If they both get the information earlier, we may call a special meeting to discuss the quotes
